



MTS Trolley Cash Fares: Fares are based on number of stations traveled. All passengers 6 and over must have a valid fare before boarding the trolley

Day Tripper Pass: Provides unlimited rides in the Trolley and most MTS Bus routes only for days valid. Day Tripper passes purchased from a Trolley ticket machine expire at midnight of the last day purchased

- To purchase your fare at a trolley ticket machine:**
- 1) Select the ticket or pass that will best meet your travel needs
 - 2) Choose the correct fare by identifying the letter designation (A-E) of your destination station on the Trolley route map.
 - 3) Insert Payment. Deposit coins and/ or bills according to the instructions on the ticket vending machine information panel.
 - 4) Most ticket machines accept coins; \$1, \$5, and \$10 bills; some also accept \$20-NOTE: maximum change given is \$5
 - 5) Take Ticket and change from below
 - 6) Keep your ticket ready for fare inspectors as you wait and ride.

Special Event Service: MTS Trolley offers increased service between Qualcomm Stadium and the Convention Center/PETCO Park area for all Padres baseball games, Holiday Bowl, as well as specific downtown events. Increased Trolley service will begin operating approximately two hours before most games or major events. For Padres games, the last train will depart the Gaslamp Quarter Station one hour after the final out.

One-Way: Trolley one-way tickets are valid for two hours from the time of purchase for a specific number of stations. Regulations require that your ticket be valid at all times while you are on board the Trolley. If you cannot complete your one-way trip within the two-hour time period, you must disembark and purchase another ticket to complete your journey.

Round-Trip: Cost is double the one-way fare. Return trip is allowed any time during the same operating day. A valid ticket may be used to transfer to an MTS Bus within the two-hour time limit from the time of purchase. Upgrades required if one-way Trolley ticket value less than the one-way fare of the Bus.
